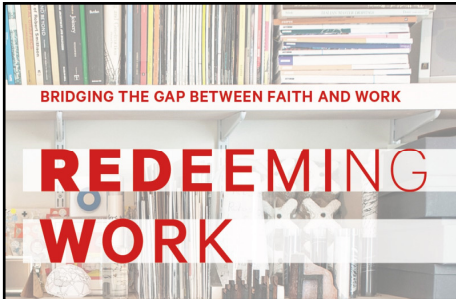

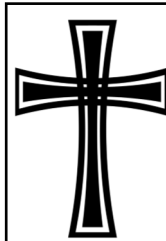


### Food Truck Community Dinner Wednesday, October 11, 5:30–6:45 p.m.
