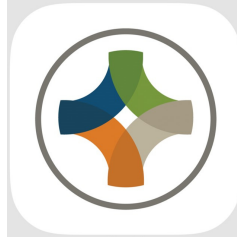
To enhance the quality of our beautiful worship music, the church organ pipes are undergoing a thorough cleaning. In addition, a new rank of oboe pipes will be added.
